Information for parents and carers



Our aim is to work with parents and carers to help all children to achieve their potential, so your attendance at this appointment is important.

Your child has been referred by another professional to see a community paediatrician (a specialist children's doctor).

This professional may be your:

- GP
- Child's teacher
- Health visitor
- School nurse
- Hospital consultant
- Speech therapist

The reasons for this referral will have been discussed with you and your consent obtained.

We are children's doctors who specialise in assessing children's health and development, from birth to leaving school. We will offer you a confidential appointment in a community based clinic. The first appointment is likely to be about an hour and may include a medical history, physical examination and developmental assessment as appropriate. At the end of your appointment the doctor will discuss with you what will happen next.

Working together to improve your care

What is your child's ethnic group?

Everyone belongs to an ethnic group. Ethnic group describes how you see yourself and is a mixture of culture, religion, language and the origins of your family. NHS Lothian staff want to give the best care they can to everyone based on health needs. Some diseases and medical conditions affect some ethnic groups more than others. By knowing how many people from different ethnic groups there are in the local population, we can plan our services better.

Why do we need this information?

We need this information for two reasons. First, we want to provide you with the best quality care. With this information doctors, nurses and other staff caring for your child will be better able to provide care that meets their needs. We only share the information collected for this reason with those who are involved in your child's care.

Secondly, so that NHS Lothian and the Scottish Government can make sure:

- Everyone is being treated fairly
- Everyone has equal access to health care
- Services meet everyone's needs.

The information used for this second reason does not have your child's name, address or health service numbers attached, so they cannot be identified.



Do I have to give this information?

You can refuse to give this information.
