### Additional Investigations

All patients who present with the following conditions or suspected clinical condition will have the following bloods taken:

<b>Diagnosis</b>	<b>Blood Sets</b>
Confusion	FBC, U/E, Glucose, CRP, Urine for microbiological examination
Stroke/TIA	FBC, U/E, lipids, ESR, glucose
Renal Colic	FBC, U/E, LFT, Urate, Ca+
Seizures	FBC, U/E, LFT, glucose, CRP, Ca+ Epileptic Drug assays
Pleuritic Chest Pain	FBC, U/E, CRP, D-Dimer, Coag
Chest Pain	FBC, U/E, lipids, admission Trop, glucose
Asthma	FBC, U/E
GI Bleed	FBC, U/E, LFT, Group and Save, Coag
Collapse	FBC, U+E, Glucose
Sepsis	FBC, U/E, LFT, glucose, CRP, lactate
Cellulitis	FBC, U/E, glucose
DVT	FBC, U/E, LFT, Coag, D-Dimer
Abdominal Pain	FBC, U/E, LFT, Amylase, Urine for microbiological examination, Urine pregnancy test (if female and of child bearing age).
Pancreatitis	FBC, U/E, LFT, Amylase, Calcium, CRP, Urine for microbiological examination, LDH, Triglycerides.
