Preparing for a dental visit

- Coming to the dentist can be difficult for anyone.
- Visits can be **easier** if they are carefully **planned**.
- Let the dental team know in advance about your child and things that make it easier/ harder for them to cope with new people and places.

You can use the attached tear off letter or phone us up.

- Ask the dental team if you (and your child) can **visit** the surgery before the main appointment.
- Ask if you can take **photos** on your phone to make a picture story of the dental appointment which you can share with your child.
- Ask for an appointment **time** that will suit your child. Often this is at the beginning of the day.

- Ask the dental team for **advice** about the best ways to look after your child's teeth and keep them healthy.
