Going to the dentist

 Let the dental team know about you (your child). Tell them about things that make it easier/ harder for you to cope with new people and places.

It is best if you tell the team before your appointment.

You can use the 'Dear Dental Team' letter on this form or phone us up.

- Ask the dental team if you can visit the clinic before the main appointment.
- Ask if you can take photos on your phone. You can make a picture story of the dental appointment.
- Ask for an appointment at a time that is best for you.
 Often this is at the beginning of the day.

- Ask the dental team for advice about the best ways to look after your teeth and keep them healthy.
- If you need more help preparing for your dental appointment please ask for a member of our Childsmile team to contact you.
