What is a Renal Social Worker?

A Renal Social Worker is a qualified social worker who works in collaboration with other members of the renal multidisciplinary team. We can refer to community social work teams and various organisations as needed.

The Renal Social Work team can help with various issues arising from a new renal diagnosis and living with a long-term illness such as chronic kidney disease (CKD). We can provide information, advice, and assistance to all renal patients.

We understand that if someone has kidney failure it can affect everyone in the family in different ways and we are here to offer support to all family members and carers.

We can give advice and support on a range of personal, emotional, and practical matters.

How can I contact the Renal Social Work Service?

The service is available to:

- Clinic outpatients
- Inpatients of the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh
- Dialysis patients receiving treatment in a dialysis unit at St. John's Hospital, Borders General Hospital, Western General Hospital, and Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh
- Patients dialysing at home
- Patients awaiting transplantation or post-transplant
- Patients who have chosen conservative care.

If you would like to arrange to speak to a Renal Social Worker, you can access the service by speaking to a member of staff from your Renal or Dialysis Unit about making a referral for you.

We are based at the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh, but we support renal patients and their families across the Lothians and Scottish Borders. We can meet with people in outpatient clinics, on the ward, in the dialysis units, or at home.
