When you telephone your Practice on **0300 790 6277** for same day support you will be asked to press option one from our telephone call menu.

Your call will go to a dedicated team trained to help you get to the right person at the right time. There are a number of different ways you can be helped, including:

- A call-back from the Primary Care Triage Team
- A same/next day appointment with our CWIC (Collaborative Working for Integrated Care) service
- An appointment with your local healthcare professional at your Practice
- If appropriate you may be directed to another form of care such as a pharmacist or optician
- Self care advice.

The Primary Care Triage Team is a specialist service provided by NHS 24 and can only be accessed through your Practice.

Those who need to see a GP will still do so, but for some, their needs will be best met by seeing another health professional. East Lothian Health and Social Care Partnership's CWIC (Collaborative Working for Integrated Care) service is a team of multidisciplinary health professionals who support practices and includes:

- Advanced Nurse Practitioners
- Mental health specialist
- Nurse practitioners
- Physiotherapy specialists
