We are a small team of specialist Speech and Language Therapists who work with deaf children across all of Lothian.

We work closely with a wide team of professionals including:

We can work directly with the child/young person but more often we work with their communication partners to provide advice and support strategies to improve their home/education environment.

Our aim is to help the child/young person to develop their communication skills to their full potential.

As the child progresses, the input may vary and an SLT may not always be involved with your child but we are always available for consultation.
