SCOTTISH NATIONAL SPINE SERVICE You have recently been fitted with your new spinal brace. We always recommend you wear a long, snug fitting and preferably seamless vest or t-shirt underneath your brace. This can be generic base layers or for younger children, you may find vests with poppers are more suitable.

If your brace is high under the arms, a short-sleeved t-shirt or vest with underarm flaps is recommended but not essential.

You will be provided with a vest at your first brace fitting appointment and your Orthotist will give you some tips on vests that may best suit you.
