# Information for patients

This leaflet is about the Hepatopancreatobiliary (HPB) Cancer Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS) Team and helps to explain what we do and what you can expect from us.

#### What is HPB cancer?

You have been given this leaflet because you have been referred to the HPB Oncology team. We are a team of specialist doctors and nurses who care for and treat people with cancers of the pancreas, liver, biliary tract and duodenum. # What is a clinical nurse specialist (CNS)?

We are a team of experienced registered nurses with specialist knowledge and education in cancer and cancer treatments. We are a point of contact for you and the people close to you, and can provide specialist advice on cancer treatments, managing symptoms, nutrition, and emotional support. Our aim is to provide a holistic specialist nursing service for patients with HPB cancers across NHS Lothian. We provide support, education and advice to colleagues and work closely with teams in the community such as GPs, district nurses, dietitians, and specialist palliative care teams.

A diagnosis of cancer can be life-changing for you and the people close to you. Please let us know what matters to you when we meet with you. We are here to answer any questions you may have, so please do contact us if you need to.
